- All budgeting must have research attached to prove costs
- ☐ Pictures need to be found and included to help showcase your adventures

Assume you already own a car that gets about 35 mpg. Can only use on public roads.

This can be great for saving time getting where you're going!



Use websites and ticketing information to budget for trains, buses and ferries.

This can be great for saving money and meeting people along the way!



You can shop or eat out, but you must have the right diet (and supplies) to stay healthy.

If you are hiking or moving a lot, remember to account for those calories!



Find lodging info on websites for national, state or local parks. No squatting!

Remember that some places are actually free if you find permitting online.
